Re: **DOE Chief Information Officer Branch UMCC Meeting**

The DOE Chief Information Officer Branch (CIOB) UMCC met on September 22, 2010 with Sister Manon Desormeaux, Service Officer, attending. The following represents a summary of the issues addressed.

### **CIOB Funding**

The bargaining agents raised concerns with respect to the impact of the budget on staffing. The Department responded that because CIOB is staffed beyond the core funding level, the Branch will bring the staffing down to the core funding level to reflect the current active projects.

The Branch indicated that it foresees that the reduction in staffing can be achieved through natural attrition over the next three years. The Branch does not foresee any WFA at this time and is currently assisting employees to move forward with their career in the Public Service.

### **CIOB HR Plan 2010-2011**

The Integrated HR Business Plan for 2010/2011 is undergoing a final review and will be provided in the next few weeks.
